The EU has installed its newest package that provided for stricter sanctions, thus adopting a tighter stronghold on companies complying with EU 833/2014.

In conducting our due diligence, we are required to ensure compliance with these regulations. Therefore we require that our customers do not sell, export, re-export, directly or indirectly to the Russian Federation any parts manufactured by Robert Bosch GmbH that we supply to you in compliance with EU 833/2014.
