In response to California Proposition 65, Chief Enterprises has partnered with a third-party compliance management company. Throughout this cooperation we are working downstream in our supply chain, towards our goal of obtaining an overview of the listed substances present in our products. This is an ongoing process requiring extensive product and material reviews.

Chief Enterprises functions as a distributor, therefore we are subject to the discretion and performance of our suppliers in obtaining California Proposition 65 documentation. Due to the extensive costs of testing for over 900 chemicals, we are placed in a position of reliance on enactment and capabilities of our suppliers to fulfill our regulatory obligations. To the best of our knowledge, we believe our products are not harmful when in use for their intended purpose.
